Determination

The appellant's evidence is that she appeared for work on the 15th of January 2010 and found the respondent premises closed. The appellant was unable to contact the respondent. The premises were subsequently taken over by a new owner. The Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, based on the following details:

Date of termination:	15 th January 2010
Gross weekly pay:	€309.62

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

The Tribunal finds that the appeal under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005 succeeds and awards the appellant €619.24, being the equivalent to two weeks pay.
