The respondent's representative conceded that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy payment.

### **Determination:**

The Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth: 20<sup>th</sup> March 1967
Date of Commencement: 31<sup>st</sup> March 2008
Date of Termination: 21<sup>st</sup> May 2010

Gross Weekly Pay: €820.00

It should be noted that payments from the social insurance fund are limited to a maximum of 600.00 per week.

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
