Based on the uncontested evidence of the appellant the Tribunal awards him a redundancy lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:

Date of Termination:	21 st April 2011
Gross Pay:	€900.00

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in employment which is insurable for all purposes under the relevant Social Welfare Acts.

It should be noted that a statutory weekly ceiling of €600.00 applies to payments from the Social Insurance Fund.

The Tribunal awards the appellant €1,800.00, two weeks pay, in respect of his statutory notice entitlement under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts 1973 to 2005.
