The determination of the Tribunal was as follows:-

The Tribunal was satisfied that the respondent was properly served with notice of the hearing. However, the claims brought were not disputed by the respondent.

The appellant's claims under the Unfair Dismissals Acts, 1977 to 2007, and under the Redundancy

Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, were withdrawn.

The Tribunal awards the claimant €5,787.52 compensation (this amount being the equivalent of eight weeks' gross pay at €723.44 per week) under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005.

The Tribunal awards the claimant €1,446.88 (this amount being the equivalent of two weeks' gross pay at €723.44 per week) as compensation for arrears of holiday pay under the Organisation of Working Time Act, 1997.
