The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

The appellant claimed that his employment, which commenced on 18 September 2005, ended by reason of redundancy on 22 January 2010. His gross weekly pay was €638.56.

No contesting evidence was offered by or on behalf of the respondent at the hearing.

**Determination:**

Under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum based on the following details:

Date of birth:	28 October 1982
Date of commencement:	18 September 2005
Date of termination:	22 January 2010
Gross weekly pay:	€638.56

It should be noted that payments from the Social Insurance Fund are limited to a maximum of €600.00 per week.

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
