Based on the appellant's uncontested evidence the Tribunal finds that he is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth:	27 th January 1981
Date of Commencement:	26 th February 2007
Date of Termination:	1 st August 2010
Gross Weekly Pay:	€437.96

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

It was conceded by the appellant that as he served form RP9 on his employer he was therefore not entitled to a payment under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005. Accordingly, the claim under these Acts is dismissed.
