**Determination:**

The respondent conceded that a redundancy situation applied in this case.

The Tribunal awards the appellant a redundancy payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth: 6<sup>th</sup> December 1968  
Date of Commencement: 9<sup>th</sup> September 2002  
Date of Termination: 27<sup>th</sup> August 2010  
Gross Weekly Wage: €661.00

It should be noted that a statutory weekly ceiling of €600.00 currently applies to payments from the Social Insurance Fund.

This award is made subject to the appellant fulfilling current social welfare requirements in relation to PRSI contributions.
