The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

**Determination**

On the uncontested evidence of the appellant, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth	13 <sup>th</sup> December 1970
Employment commenced	23 <sup>rd</sup> October 2006
Employment ended	6 <sup>th</sup> November 2009
Gross weekly pay	€346

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

The Tribunal also awards the appellant his statutory entitlement of €692, being the sum due for two weeks holiday pay, under the Organisation of Working Time Act, 1997.
