Determination

The Tribunal is satisfied based on the uncontested evidence of the appellant that he was dismissed by reason of redundancy. Accordingly the Tribunal awards him a redundancy lump

sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts 1967 to 2007 based on the following information:

Date of Birth:	23 rd April 1958
Date of commencement of employment:	1 st April 2004
Date of termination of employment:	12 th September 2009
Gross weekly pay:	€739.62

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

It should be noted that a statutory weekly ceiling of €600.00 applies to payments from the Social Insurance Fund.
