Determination

The Tribunal is disposed to extend the time limit for lodging an appeal, as prescribed in the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007.

The respondent conceded that a redundancy situation existed. The Tribunal find that the appellant is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria.

Date of Birth:	24 th October 1974
Employment commenced:	6 th April 2000
Employment ended:	7 th November 2008
Gross weekly pay:	€449.20

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

The Tribunal awards the appellant €1796.80, being the equivalent to four weeks' pay, under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005.
