Determination:

At the outset the claim under the Unfair Dismissals Acts was withdrawn. In circumstances where the liquidator had informed the Tribunal in writing that he had no objection to any ruling that the Tribunal might make and did not intend to attend the hearing the Tribunal is satisfied, based on the uncontroverted evidence, that the appellant is entitled to receive a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria
