The director of the company confirmed that the appellant's employment had terminated by reason of redundancy. The director consented to the amending of the form T1A to reflect the fact that the respondent is a limited company.

Determination:

The Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth: 1st June 1980
Date of Commencement: 13th October 2003
Date of Termination: 3rd February 2010

Gross Weekly Pay: €638.43

It should be noted that payments from the social insurance fund are limited to a maximum of €600.00 per week.

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social

Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
