## Determination

The respondent conceded that a redundancy situation existed. The Tribunal awards the appellant a redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth:	19 <sup>th</sup> July 1986
Date of Commencement:	21 <sup>st</sup> August 2005
Date of Termination:	5 <sup>th</sup> February 2010
Gross Pay:	€626.70

It should be noted that a statutory weekly ceiling of €600.00 applies to payments from the Social Insurance Fund. Please note that this award is made subject to the appellant having beenin insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

The respondent conceded that the appellant did not receive his statutory minimum notice. The Tribunal awards the appellant €1253.40, being two weeks' pay, under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005.

The appellant did not offer any evidence to support his appeal under the Organisation of Working Time Act, 1997.
