Determination

Being satisfied that the respondent was properly on notice of the hearing, and having considered the uncontested evidence of the appellant, the Tribunal awards a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria.

Date of Birth: 22nd August 1981
Date of Commencement: 7th September 2007
Date of Termination: 22nd December 2009
Gross Weekly Wage: €588.00

The appellant was on lay-off for a two month period within in the three years immediately preceding the termination of his employment.

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts, during the relevant period.
