The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

On the uncontested evidence of the appellant, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth 30th July 1956 Employment commenced 7th October 2002 Employment ended 25th June 2010

Gross weekly pay €750

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period. It should be noted that payments from the social insurance fund are limited to a maximum of ϵ 600-00 per week

The Tribunal awards the appellant his statutory entitlement of €3,000 being the sum due for four weeks' notice, under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005.
