The determination of the Tribunal was as follows:

The appeal under the Organisation of Working Time Act 1997 was withdrawn.

#### Determination

The Tribunal was satisfied that the respondent was properly on notice of the hearing. Based on the uncontested evidence of the appellants, the Tribunal finds that they are each entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following information:

Appellant 1 Date of Birth Employment commenced Employment ended Gross weekly pay

31 January 1972 12 May 2003 4 November 2009 €316.60

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

The appeal by appellant 1 under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005 succeeds and he is awarded the sum of €1266.40 being 4 weeks pay.

Appellant 2 Date of Birth Employment commenced Employment ended Gross weekly pay

29 November 1972 01 January 2004 26 November 2009 €568.41

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

Appellant 3 Date of Birth Employment commenced Employment ended Gross weekly pay

21 August 1960 7 July 1996 29 April 2009 €595.89

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

Appellant 4 Date of Birth Employment commenced

16 June 1964 8 February 2001 Employment ended Gross weekly pay 29 April 2009 €724.00
