The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

Determination

There was no appearance by or on behalf of the respondent on the day of the hearing. The respondent's representative had formally contacted the Tribunal in advance of the hearing date to advise that no one from the respondent would be in attendance.

The Tribunal is satisfied having heard the evidence of the appellant that he was dismissed by reason of redundancy. Accordingly the Tribunal awards the appellant a redundancy lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts 1967 to 2007 based on the following information:
