The respondent having conceded liability in this regard, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:

Normal weekly remuneration: €595.50 Non-reckonable service: Nil Amount of redundancy payment: €10981.02 This award is subject to the appellant having been in employment which is insurable for all purposes under the Social Welfare Consolidation Act 2005.

The Tribunal awards the appellant the sum of €238.20 being the equivalent of two days outstanding pay under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts 1973 to 2005.

The Tribunal also awards the appellant the sum of €628.84 in respect of outstanding holiday pay under the Organisation of Working Time Act, 1997.
