The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

The appellant claimed that his employment, which commenced on 11 November 1996, ended by reason of redundancy on 30 April 2010. His gross weekly pay was €389.15.

A hearing notice was sent to the respondent but no evidence was offered by or on behalf of the

respondent at the hearing to dispute the appellant's entitlement to a redundancy lump sum.

Determination:

Under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum based on the following details:

Date of commencement:	11 November 1996
Date of termination:	30 April 2010
Gross weekly pay:	€389.15
