The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

The Tribunal is satisfied that the respondent was properly notified of this hearing.
Neither the respondent nor a representative on his behalf appeared for the hearing.

Having heard and considered the uncontested evidence of the appellant the Tribunal finds that this employment was terminated by way of redundancy. Accordingly, the appeal under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 is allowed and the appellant is awarded a statutory lump sum under those Acts, and based on the following:
