The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

**Determination:**

The respondent conceded that a redundancy situation applied in this case.

The Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth: 12<sup>th</sup> April 1963  
Date of Commencement: 27<sup>th</sup> September 2006  
Date of Termination: 31<sup>st</sup> August 2009  
Gross Weekly Wage: €648.33

This award is subject to the appellant having been in employment, which is insurable for all purposes under the Social Welfare Consolidation Act 2005.

It should be noted that a weekly ceiling of €600.00 currently applies to payments from the Social Insurance Fund.
