Having heard the uncontested evidence adduced by the appellant and the documentation submitted the Tribunal finds that the appellant was made redundant. Accordingly, the appeal under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 succeeds and awards the appellant a redundancy lump sum, which is to be calculated on the basis of the following criteria:

21st August 1959 Date of Birth: 10th October 2006 Date of Commencement: 19th March 2010 Date of Termination:

Gross Pay: €450.00

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

The case under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005, succeeds and the Tribunal awards the Appellant the sum of € 900.00, this being two weeks gross pay as compensation in lieu of notice.

The appeal under the Organisation of Working Time Act, 1997, succeeds and the Tribunal awards the appellant the sum of €2,610.00, this being for 10 days public holidays and 19 days annual leave.
