The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

Determination:

Based on the appellant's uncontested evidence the Tribunal finds that he is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth: 27th October 1975
Date of Commencement: 15th June 2006
Date of Termination: 16th July 2010

Gross Weekly Pay: €638.43

It should be noted that payments from the social insurance fund are limited to a maximum of €600.00 per week.

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
The appeal under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005 was withdrawn.
