The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

The appellant claimed that her employment, which commenced on 11 July 2005, ended by reason of redundancy on 22 December 2009. Her gross weekly pay was €492.61.

A hearing notice was sent to the respondent but no evidence was offered by or on behalf of the respondent at the hearing to dispute the appellant's entitlement to a redundancy lump sum.

Determination:

Under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum based on the following details:

Date of birth:	2 February 1977
Date of commencement:	11 July 2005
Date of termination:	22 December 2009
Gross weekly pay:	€492.61

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
