The Tribunal is satisfied that all parties were properly notified of the hearing.

The appellant gave uncontested evidence of commencing employment with the respondent on the 1st January 1999 as a site foreman and worked continuously until 2005. At that time according to the evidence a transfer of undertaking occurred when the respondent took on a business partner. The appellant's employment continued and there was no break in his service. The appellant told the Tribunal that his position was made redundant at a date in June 2008. The appellant produced no documentation in this regard and the Tribunal relies on the uncontested evidence of the appellant. The appellant was asked at the time of his redundancy tocomplete and sign an RP50 form which he did but to date has not received any redundancy payment.

On the basis of the uncontested evidence the Tribunal awards the appellant a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts 1967 to 2007 based on the following
