Determination:

There was no appearance or representation for the respondent in this case. The Tribunal are satisfied that the respondent was properly notified.

The Tribunal heard uncontested evidence from the claimant. The Tribunal also heard detailed and extensive submissions from counsel. The claimant told the Tribunal that her position was not redundant and she was dismissed because of a purported redundancy. She did not accept that her position was redundant.

The Tribunal determines that the claim under the Unfair Dismissals Acts 1977 to 2007 succeeds. The Tribunal determines that compensation be the most appropriate remedy. Accordingly, the Tribunal makes an award of €17,000.00 to the claimant, under the terms of the Unfair Dismissals Acts 1977 to 2007.
