Date employment ended	11 th August 2008
Gross weekly pay	€430.00

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

The appellant is entitled to two weeks gross pay in lieu of notice the amount of €860.00 (€430.00 per week) under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts 1973 to 2005.
