The appeal under the Organisation of Working Time Act 1997 was withdrawn.

Determination

The Tribunal was satisfied that the respondent was properly on notice of the hearing. Based on the uncontested evidence of the appellants, the Tribunal finds that they are each entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following information:
