Determination:

The Tribunal is satisfied that the respondent was properly notified of this hearing. Neither they nor representatives on their behalf appeared for this case.

Having considered uncontested evidence from both claimants, the Tribunal allows the claims under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007.

The Tribunal awards the claimants a lump sum redundancy payment each under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:

It should be noted that payments from the Social Insurance Fund are limited to a maximum of €600.00 per week.

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

The claims under the Unfair Dismissals Acts, 1977 to 2007 were dismissed.
