The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

The appellant, a cleaning supervisor, claimed that her employment, which commenced on 8 January 2002, ended by reason of redundancy in November 2010 (after she had been ill since May 2008) when she found that her employer had ceased trading. Her gross weekly pay (as a part-time employee working some twenty hours) had been €250.00.

A hearing notice was sent to the respondent but no evidence was offered by or on behalf of the respondent at the hearing.

## **Determination:**

Under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum based on the following details:

Date of birth:29 December 1960Date of commencement:08 January 2002Date of termination:15 November 2010Gross weekly pay:€250.00

The Tribunal finds the period from 16 May 2008 to 14 November 2010 to have been a period of non-reckonable service due to illness.

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
