The determination of the Tribunal was as follows:

Determination:

At the outset on the first day the claims under the Unfair Dismissals Acts were withdrawn.

Based on the uncontroverted evidence the Tribunal is satisfied that the claimants were dismissed by reason of redundancy and, accordingly, are entitled to lump sum payments under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the criteria set out in the following schedule

These awards are made subject to the claimants having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

Both claimants are entitled to four weeks' pay under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005, €1,995-96 in the case of the first named claimant and €2,084-00 in the case of the second named claimant. Recovery of this part of the award will be problematic as the respondent has been dissolved since March 2010
