The determination of the Tribunal was as follows:-

This case came before the Tribunal by way of an appeal by an employer appealing against the decision of the Rights Commissioner reference r-076818-ud-09/JT dated the 14<sup>th</sup> December 2009.

## **Determination**

Counsel for the appellant outlined to the Tribunal that the respondent commenced employment with the appellant on the 31<sup>st</sup> October 2007 and due to the economic downturn his employment was terminated on the 15<sup>th</sup> February 2008. He was then re-employed on the 31<sup>st</sup> March 2008 until the 22<sup>nd</sup> December 2008. As there was a break in the respondent's service he did not have the requisite service to pursue a claim under the Unfair Dismissals Acts, 1977 to 2007.

The solicitor for the respondent conceded that the respondent did not have the requisite continuous service to pursue a claim under the Unfair Dismissals Acts 1977 to 2007.

The Tribunal does not have jurisdiction to hear the case, it upsets the decision of the Rights Commissioner and the case fails.
