The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

This case came before the Tribunal by way of an employer (the appellant) appealing the decision of a Rights Commissioner reference: r-081489-pw-09/RG.

The basis for the employer's appeal was that the Rights Commissioner failed to take account of an extra week's wages paid to the employee upon the termination of his employment which discharged the employee's entitlement to minimum notice.

Determination:

Based on the employer's uncontested evidence the Tribunal finds that the employee was paid in lieu of notice. The Tribunal therefore varies the order of the Rights Commissioner under the Payment of Wages, 1991 (reference r-081489-pw-09/RG) by finding that the sum awarded to the employee should be €1,063.36.
