The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

The respondent conceded that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy payment.

Determination:

The Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, based on the following criteria:

Date of birth: 4th May 1980
Date of commencement: 22nd November 2007
Date of termination: 24th May 2010
Gross weekly pay: €344.00

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

The Tribunal also finds that the appellant is entitled to the sum of €688.00 being the equivalent of

two weeks gross wages under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005.
