The determination of the Tribunal was as follows:-

At the outset a jurisdictional point was raised in that the respondent did not accept that the claimant had been its employee for one year. The Tribunal decided to conduct a hearing into this issue and make a decision on its jurisdiction.

Determination:

Having carefully considered the case made by both sides on the jurisdiction point, the Tribunal was not satisfied that the claimant began employment on the 1st January 2007. The Tribunal is satisfied that the claimant began employment with the respondent on the 1st January 2009 and does not have the requisite one year's service with the respondent. Consequently, the claim under the Unfair Dismissals Acts, 1977 to 2007 is dismissed.
