Determination:

The Tribunal is satisfied that the respondent was properly notified of this hearing. Neither they nor representatives on their behalf appeared for this case.

Having considered uncontested evidence from the claimant, the Tribunal allows the claim under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007.

The Tribunal awards the claimant a lump sum redundancy payment each under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

Loss having been established, the tribunal awards the sum of € 1,320.00, this being two weeks gross wages, under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005.

The claim under the Unfair Dismissals Acts, 1977 to 2007 was dismissed.
