The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

It was common case that a redundancy situation existed.

The Tribunal is satisfied that the appellants were dismissed by reason of redundancy. Accordingly, the Tribunal awards each of the appellants a redundancy lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:

Appellant 1

Date of birth: 12th January 1984
Date of commencement: 3rd January 2006
Date of termination: 13th November 2009
Gross weekly pay: €441.40

Appellant 2

Date of birth: 31st December 1968
Date of commencement: 28th May 2007
Date of termination: 13th November 2009
Gross weekly pay: €388.00

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

The appeals under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005 are allowed. *Appellant 1* is awarded the sum of €882.80 being equivalent to two weeks' gross pay and *Appellant 2* is awarded the sum of €776.00 being equivalent to two weeks' gross pay under the Acts.
