The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

The appellant claimed that his employment, which commenced on 3 January 2006, ended by reason of redundancy on 3 December 2010. His gross weekly pay was €946.84.

No evidence was offered by or on behalf of the respondent at the hearing to dispute the appellant's entitlement to a redundancy lump sum.

Determination:

Under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum based on the following details:

Date of birth:	30 July 1973
Date of commencement:	03 January 2006
Date of termination:	03 December 2010
Gross weekly pay:	€946.84

It should be noted that payments from the Social Insurance Fund are limited to a maximum of €600.00 per week.

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
