Determination

The tribunal heard evidence from both the appellant and the respondent in this case. The Tribunal are satisfied that a transfer of undertaking took place between respondent A and respondent B. The Tribunal are further satisfied that there was no cessation of trading and that respondent B continued to operate the business as here to fore.

Accordingly, the Tribunal determine that respondent B is deemed to be the employer in respect of the applicant's liability for redundancy payment.

The Tribunal find that the appellant is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria.

Employment commenced:	15 March 1983
Employment ended:	25 November 2009
Gross weekly pay:	€214.15

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
