It was common case that the appellant was paid his full statutory entitlement under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007. However the appellant stated that other employees who were made redundant after him received more than statutory redundancy and the appellant brought this appeal in order to compel the employer to pay him more.

Determination

The Tribunal has no jurisdiction to award more than statutory redundancy. Therefore this appeal is dismissed.
