Background:

This case is before the Tribunal by way of an employer appealing the Decision, (ref: r-085838-pw-09/GC), (PW106/2010) of a Rights Commissioner under the Payments of wages

Act 1991.

Determination:

There was no appearance by the appellant (employer) or representation present for the employer. The Tribunal is satisfied that proper notification was sent to the employer. Accordingly, the appeal under the Payments of wages Act 199, fails.
