The determination of the Tribunal was as follows:-

The claims under the Unfair Dismissals Acts, 1977 to 2007, the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005, and the Organisation of Working Time Act, 1997, were withdrawn.

The appellant claimed that his employment, which commenced on 1 May 2002, ended by

reason of redundancy on 30 April 2010. His gross weekly pay was €573.00.

No evidence was offered by or on behalf of the respondent at the hearing to dispute the

appellant's entitlement to a redundancy lump sum.

Determination:

The claims under the Unfair Dismissals Acts, 1977 to 2007, the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005, and the Organisation of Working Time Act, 1997, were withdrawn.

Under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum based on the following details:

Date of birth: 31 August 1963

Date of commencement: 01 May 2002

Date of termination: 30 April 2010

Gross weekly pay: €573.00

It should be noted that payments from the Social Insurance Fund are limited to a maximum of €600.00 per week.

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
