The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

Giving evidence, the claimant stated that his redundancy payment of €5,309.93 was incorrectly calculated as he should have been paid the Registered Employment Agreement rate of €638 Gross. It was stated by the claimant's representative that Section 10 of the Redundancy Payments Act, 1971 applies in this case.

Determination

The Tribunal, being satisfied that the respondent was properly on notice of the hearing, finds based on the uncontroverted evidence, that the appellant is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:

19th February 2010 €638

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period. It should be noted that payments from the social insurance fund are limited to a maximum of ϵ 00-00 per week.
