The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

Appellant's case

The appellant stated that he commenced employment with the respondent on 21st September 2001. His employment ended on 25th January 2010. At the time of termination of employment the appellant was being paid €576.92 gross per week. The appellant did not receive any payment from the respondent in respect of a lump sum redundancy payment.

Determination:

Having considered the uncontested evidence of the appellant the Tribunal awards him a lump sum redundancy payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria.

D.O.B. 24th February 1970
Commencement Date: 21st September 2001

Termination date 25th January 2010
Gross pay €576.92

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

It should be noted that payments from the social insurance fund are limited to a maximum of €600.00 per week.
