The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

Determination:

The Tribunal heard evidence that the respondent company is now in liquidation and conceded that a redundancy situation applied in this case.

The Tribunal awards the appellant a redundancy payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth:	23 rd January 1958
Date of Commencement:	1 st March 2001
Date of Termination:	6 th January 2010
Gross Weekly Wage:	€683.65

A ceiling of €600.00 applies to any payments from the Social Insurance Fund and this award is subject to the claimant having been in employment, which is insurable for all purposes under the

Social Welfare Consolidation Act 2005.
