Background

It was common case that the appellant commenced employment with the respondent on 16^{th} October 2006 and was made redundant, without notice, on 24^{th} September 2010. At the date of termination the appellant was earning $\in 328.55$ gross per week.

The respondent stated that he was unable to pay the appellant his minimum notice or redundancy lump sum due to financial constraints.

Determination

Having considered the evidence adduced the Tribunal awards the appellant €657.10 under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005 and a lump sum redundancy payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria.

Date notice received	N/A
Termination date	24 th September 2010
Gross pay	€328.55
