There was no appearance by or on behalf of the respondent. Notification of the hearing was sent by registered post to both EMPLOYERS. The notification sent to The Secretary could not be delivered by An Post and was returned to the Tribunal and the Tribunal then sent the notice by ordinary post. However the notice sent by registered post to EMPLOYER 1 was delivered by An Post. Therefore the Tribunal is satisfied that the respondents were properly notified of the hearing.

Claimant's case

The appellant stated that she commenced employment with the respondent on 10th April 2008 and was let go when the business closed down on 29th March 2011. At the time of termination of employment the appellant was being paid €140.00 gross per week. The appellant did not receive any payment from the respondent in respect of a lump sum redundancy payment. The

claimant received three days notice of redundancy.

Determination

Having considered the uncontested evidence of the appellant the Tribunal awards her €196.00 under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005 and a lump sum redundancy payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria.

Termination date	29 th March 2011
Gross pay	€140.00
