There was no appearance by or on behalf of the respondent and the Tribunal is satisfied that they were properly notified of the hearing.

At the outset the appellant withdrew his claims under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005 and the Organisation of Working Time Act, 1997.

The appellant stated that he commenced employment with the respondent on 17<sup>th</sup> December 2007 and was let go when the business closed down on 27<sup>th</sup> July 2010. At the time of termination of employment the appellant was being paid €500.00 gross per week. The appellant did not receive any payment from the respondent in respect of a lump sum redundancy payment.

## **Determination**

Having considered the uncontested evidence of the appellant the Tribunal awards him a lump sum redundancy payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the

following criteria.

Commencement Date	17 <sup>th</sup> December 2007
Date notice received	N/A
Termination date	27 <sup>th</sup> July 2010
Gross pay	€500.00 per week

This award is made subject to the claimant having been in insurable employment, during the relevant period, in accordance with the Social Welfare Acts.
