The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

Determination:

The Tribunal is satisfied that the respondents were duly notified of the hearing. Neither the respondents nor a representative on their behalf appeared at this hearing.

Based on the uncontested evidence of the appellant, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth:	23 rd March 1971
Date of Commencement:	15 th October 2007
Date of Termination:	29 th January 2010
Gross Weekly Wage:	€607.03

It should be noted that a statutory weekly ceiling of €600.00 currently applies to payments from the Social Insurance Fund.

This award is subject to the appellant having been in employment, which is insurable for all

purposes under the Social Welfare Consolidation Act, 2005.
