Background

It was common case that the appellant commenced employment with the respondent on 17^{th} October 1998 and was made redundant on 24^{th} September 2010. At the date of redundancy the appellant was earning €838.11 gross per week. There were two periods of lay-off one from 23^{rd} July 2010 to 16^{th} August 2010 and the other from 4^{th} September 2010 to 17^{th} September 2010.

Determination

The Tribunal finds that the appellant was dismissed by reason of redundancy and awards him €14,808.00 under the Redundancy Payments Acts 1967 to 2007 as per the criteria set out below.
